Eligibility-

Any two- or three-dimensional works in ceramics, drawing, fiber, glass, metal, painting, stone, wood, or mixed media will be eligible. This show does not accept photography. Works of artists selected for the GMCC Art Show must have been completed within the last three years. Two-dimensional works must be ready to hang and in general may not exceed five feet in any one direction including the frame. Any size exception should first be discussed with the Art Coordinators. Framing should be done in a professional manner using conservation-quality materials. Each exhibiting artist will be asked to submit five works with the expectation that at least three will be shown. ALL ART MUST BE FOR SALE. The exhibition committee reserves the right to reject any work on inspection of the actual piece.

The Exhibition

The exhibition will be professionally hung and maintained by a trained staff. Artists are invited but not required to attend the show. For artists juried into the show, a special area is available for limited edition prints and other limited production pieces including notecards.

Awards

Peoples choice awards will be presented.

New Scholarship Fund

Selected artists will be asked to donate a piece of work to be auctioned to fund our promising high school arts scholarship.

Application

For jury consideration, the following application materials must be postmarked by May 6, 2009.

1a. 2" x 2" 35mm professional quality slides of five two-dimensional works, or, for three-dimensional works, slides showing two views. Each slide should be labeled with the following information:

- Name at the top of the slide
- Arrow at right top corner
- Number correlating to Description of Entries.

1b. Digital images on CD will also be accepted. Images need to correlate with description of entries. Please note: Jurors have stated that they prefer to view works via slides.

The jury will be selecting artists and not specific works of art. The works shown for jurying need not be the pieces submitted for the exhibition, but the latter should be of the same media and style.

If you wish to have your slides/CD returned, you must include a stamped, self-addressed envelope. GMCC cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to media.

2. Completed Entry Form and Description of Entries.
3. A non-refundable entry fee of \$20.00 made payable to GMCC.
4. A résumé and artist's statement.

The Green Mountain Cultural Center, formed in 1988, has brought a variety of cultural events to Vermont's Mad River Valley, home of Mad River Glen and Sugarbush ski resort areas. Chief among these events is the annual juried art show, held in the Joslyn Round Barn in Waitsfield. This exhibit has been widely acclaimed, bringing visitors from around the world.

The show opens with a reception at which the exhibiting artists are on hand to meet and mingle with many GMCC members and art lovers. GMCC also introduces the community's school children to the arts by offering guided tours of the show. Other groups, such as the elderly and those with special needs, are welcome. The barn is wheelchair accessible. Tours can be arranged by appointment.

The Round Barn, a beautifully restored structure, is also the venue for the Green Mountain Opera Festival in June and the annual Photography Exhibit during the Vermont Festival of the Arts in August. A registered national landmark, the barn offers a unique and exciting exhibition space. This architectural delight is a valuable resource in the Mad River Valley.
